Marvin L. Birnbaum, MD, PhD, holds the current positions of Emeritus Professor of Medicine and Physiology with the University of Wisconsin. He is the Vice-President for Humanitarian Affairs for the World Association for Disaster and Emergency Medicine (WADEM) and is Editor-in-Chief Emeritus of the group's official journal, *Prehospital and Disaster Medicine*. He is also a WADEM past President.

Dr. Birnbaum is co-editor of the *Health Disaster Management: Guidelines for Evaluation and Research* and has compiled a book on the medical aspects of the 2004 Indian Ocean earthquake and tsunami for the Southeast Asia Regional Office of the World Health Organization (WHO).

WADEM is a partner with the WHO Global Health Cluster (GHC), which improves humanitarian, medical and crisis coordination on the global level. Dr. Birnbaum is a member of GHC Working Group on Policy and Strategy. Dr. Birnbaum formerly served as Medical Director of the Emergency Education Center and the Paramedic Training Program with the University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics. He also worked as Medical Director of EMS for the Division of Intercollegiate Athletics, at UW-Madison, and as the Medical Director for the Madison Fire Department.
