







## ITC-DRR Master and PhD Programme Conceptual Frame Work




## ITC-DRR Internship Programme Conceptual Frame Work



#### **Organizational Structure**




## Curriculum Development and Training Structure

Emergency Situational Report Page 1 of 1 CRISIS-CENTRE INDONESIA Tuesday, 24 Nov 2009 EMERGENCY SITUATIONAL REPORT FLOOD, ACEH TIMUR ITC-DRR International Training Consortium in Disaster Risk Reduction HIGHLIGHTS On Sunday, 22<sup>nd</sup> of November 2009, at about 2 am local time, flash floods triggered by heavy torrential rains occurred in Aceh Timur District.
 The floods invalidated 12 villages in 4 Sub Districts, namely Alue ie Mirah, Alue ie Itam, Julok, and Keude Gerobak. Water level reached up to 2 meters high.
 The flood has caused infrastructures and public facilities damaged.
 MOH already set up 3 health posts in Julok, 3 in Alur Mirah, 4 in Alur Itam and 1 in Keudeu Gerobak. The medicines are adequately available in order to anticipate post-flood disease.
 MOH, Crisis Genter, Aceh Frovincial Health Office and Aceh Timur District Health Office are in close collaboration with WHO Indonesia, provided integrated Emergency Health Services according to Standard Operating Procedures. Training DRRPHS Disaster Risk Reduction Program for Health Sector SINKING FERRY, BALAI KARIMUN CAPE, KEPULAUAN RIAU PROVINCE HIGHLIGHTS Universities On 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2009, Dumai Express 10 Ferry carrying 278 passengers and 13 crew sinks in waters off Balai Karimun Cape, Kepullauan Risur Province after being hit by a 2,5 m height of wave.
 MOH, Regional Orisis Center of South Sulawesi, Provincial Health Office and District Health Office in close collaboration with WHO Indonesia, provided integrated Emergency Health Services according to Standard Operating Procedures. Cadjah Mada University Airlangga University LANDSLIDE, PURWOREJO, CENTRAL JAVA Lambung Mangkurat University Landslide in Furworejo, Central Java Province, Republic of Indonesia On Friday, 20th of November 2009 at 5 PM, a landslide incident occurred in Purworejo, Province of Central Java caused by high rainfall.
 See a caused by high rainfall.
 See a caused Cryombong Villages, Cepedak and Ciyombong. Transportation between the 2 villages is disrupted and caused Cryombong Village still isolated.
 30 houses are damaged.
 Landslide disrupted local transportation, electricity is still working. MOH, Regional Crisis Center of Central Java, Central Java Provincial Health Office and Purworejo District Health Office in close collaboration with WHO Indonesia, provided integrated Emergency Health Services according to standard Operating Procedures.
